


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
Ocean Protect

 - Captured >19.5 million kg of pollution to date














What is being captured?

8 Gully pit baskets in Western Sydney

~2720m² urban road catchment

5 months (2019)


850 bits of plastic, including:

- 228 cigarette butts
- 88 plastic drink lids
- 44 cans
- 22 plastic cups
- 21 plastic straws

130kg of sediment



Gross Pollutant Traps (GPTs)










Filter cartridges





























Filter membranes




















Take home messages

- Stormwater is a valuable resource
- Stormwater can be (and typically is) high in pollution
- Treatment assets must be:
 - Resilient (to incoming/variable loads)
 - Maintained (e.g. pollution removed)
- Maintenance compliance is essential


